

Chapter 210. Offenses

Article IV. Offenses Concerning Public Safety

Section 210.560. Fireworks.

- A. The term "fireworks", herein referred to, means all types of fireworks except sparklers.
- B. It shall be unlawful for any person to discharge or cause to be discharged any fireworks as described in this Section except as stated below:
 - 1. New Year's Eve at Midnight.
 - 2. From July 1 up to and including July 10 from 9:00 A.M. to 11:00 P.M.
- C. It shall be lawful for a person, legal entity, company or business to sell fireworks within the City limits of Truesdale, provided they meet all Federal, State, County and City laws referencing licensing, days and hours of operation, and the collecting of the applicable taxes.
- D. It shall be unlawful for any person to discharge or cause to be discharged any fireworks of any kind from a motor vehicle or towards a motor vehicle.
- E. Any individual that violates this Section **210.560** shall be subject to penalties of up to five hundred dollars (\$500.00) for each offense, or be punished by both fine and imprisonment.
